TUESDAY, SEPT. 12 MRS. HENDERSON PRESENTS (103 min.)

Recently widowed, well-to-do Laura Henderson buys an old London theater and opens it up as the Windmill, a performance hall which goes down in history, for, among other things, all nude revues. Genres: Comedy, Drama, Music, War. Starring Judi Dench and Bob Hoskins, 2005, Nominated for 2 Oscars,

TUESDAY, OCT. 17 BELLE (100 min.)

The true story of an illegitimate mixed-race daughter of a Royal Navy Admiral who is raised by her aristocratic great-uncle and his wife in 18th century England. Belle's lineage affords her certain privileges, but the color of her skin prevents her from fully participating in the traditions of her social standing. Genres: Biography, Drama, Romance. Starring Gugu Mbatha-Raw, Tom Wilkinson, Emily Watson, and Matthew Goode. 2013. Winner of 14 awards.

TUESDAY, NOV. 14 GREY GARDENS (94 min.)

Two charming eccentrics—an elderly mother and her middle-aged daughter ("Big Edie" and "Little Edie" Bouvier Beale), the aunt and cousin of Jackie Kennedy Onassis—live their lives in a filthy, decaying mansion in East Hampton. Genre: Documentary. This captivatingly honest, uncensored 1975 film, was made by pioneering documentarians Albert and David Maysles.

TUESDAY, DEC. 5

JULIA (117 min.)

Based on a chapter in Lillian Hellman's memoir *Pentimento, Julia* is the story of the playwright's lifelong friend (Vanessa Redgrave) who resisted the Nazis in the years before the war started, pulling Hellman herself (Jane Fonda) into a mission to smuggle funds into Nazi Germany. This 1977 drama received critical acclaim and 11 Oscar nominations.
