Make a collaborative movie this summer through our popular teen program, **Creators' Co-op!** Over three weeks, groups pitch, script, shoot, and edit an original narrative short.

Week one is an immersive experience with instruction in writing, acting for the camera, and directing. During weeks two and three, student production crews shoot and edit independently with times available for mentorship and feedback from the instructor.
